



# Key Instant Recall Facts

## Year 5—Summer 2

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts with **speed and accuracy**.

### I can convert a range of units

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$$1 \text{ kg} = 1000\text{g}$$

$$1\text{km} = 1000\text{m}$$

$$1\text{m} = 100\text{cm}$$

$$1\text{m} = 1000\text{mm}$$

$$1\text{cm} = 10\text{mm}$$

$$1 \text{ litre} = 1000\text{ml}$$

Write 1500m in km.

Write 2.6kg in g.
