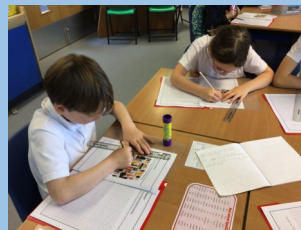

Y4 have begun researching and designing their torches in DT lessons and are loving it!



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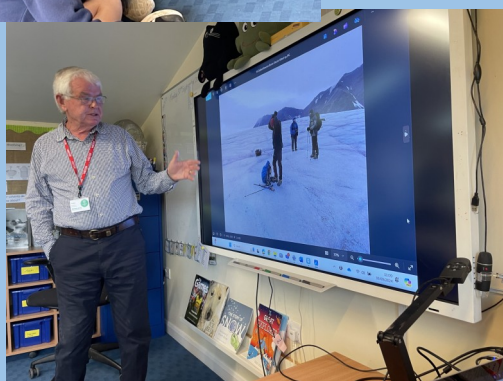
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Natural History Museum Visitor to Y5

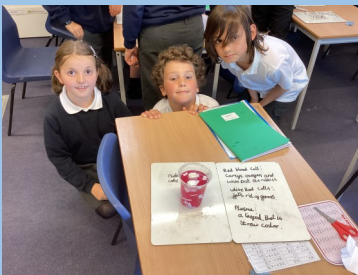
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Year 6
