Year 6 Design Technology Projects are in full swing



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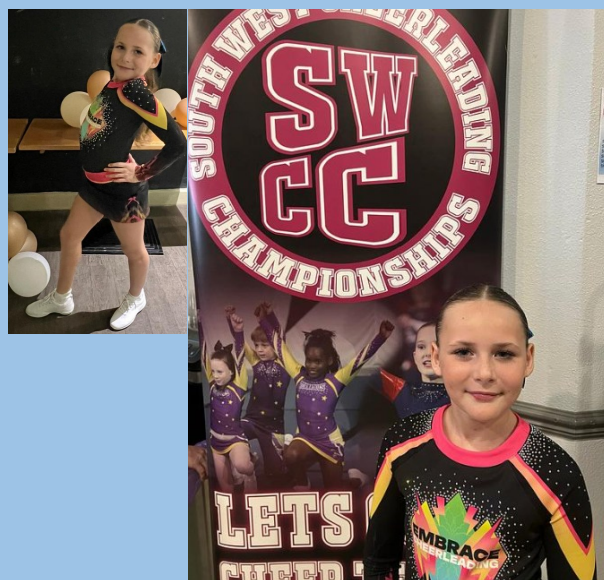


We have many children enjoying their hobbies and also competing at various levels all over Cornwall and indeed the country at weekends.

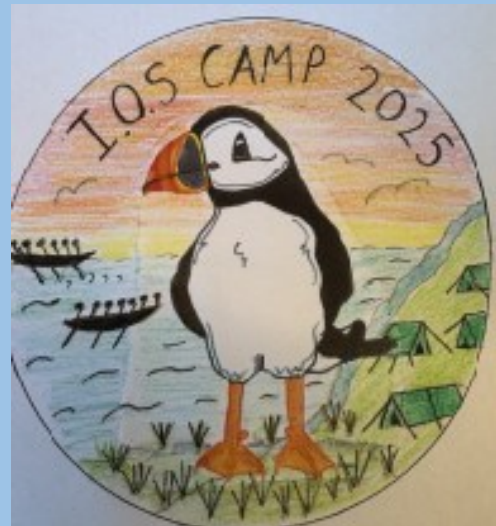
